

## Instructions Manner Neapolitaner 75 g

### InDesign/Idml:

Open template (please use the .idml-file for older InDesign versions)

bleed margin 3 mm

**fill in your design in the „layout“-layer on both pages; the graphic should only reach up to the green line (see example on this page)**

**PLEASE** be aware that the design should be completely identical on both pages!

(advice for filling in the second page: copy the design from the first page and use the „Paste in Place“-option under the edit-menu to guarantee that the design is in the right position)

**colour space CMYK** (Please do not use any Pantone or RGB colours, as they would differ from the original colour when printed! Change all colours into CMYK-colours.)

### Export ...

Once the desired design has been created, click on the menu item „File“ – „Export“ and save the design as a PDF (print):

Adobe PDF-preset: PDF/X-1a:2003

Compatibility: Acrobat 4 (PDF 1.3)

Marks and Bleeds: activate „Crop Marks“, „Bleed Marks“ and „Page Information“;

offset: approximately 2 mm

activate „Use Document Bleed Settings“ 3 mm

Output: Colour Conversion: No Colour Conversion

### Result: print PDF with 2 pages

**(page 1 includes pink cutting lines, page 2 should be without cutting lines)**

**ATTENTION:** The lines on the first page are for illustrative purposes only! This is where the banderole will be cut and folded. **ONLY** page 2 is printed (without the lines)!
